Dr Kim Hames is currently the Deputy Premier of Western Australia with responsibility over the portfolios of Health and Tourism and also has a special coordinating role for the Kimberley region.

This year will mark his 15th as an elected Member of Parliament, being elected as the member for Dianella (1993-96) and later Yokine (1996-01). He was elected as the Member for Dawesville in 2005 which is a seat he still holds.

Under the Court Government, Dr Hames was the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs, Housing and Water Resources. Prior to becoming a Member of Parliament, Kim was a councilor at the City of Bayswater for 8 years.

Dr Hames is a GP with a strong community background having served for many years as a doctor with the Army Reserve.
